#### Leadenham Church of England Primary School's Publication Scheme

Information available under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Governing Body is responsible for maintenance of this scheme.

All policies are written in accordance with the Keeping Children Safe in Education Safeguarding document and the Working Together to Safeguard Children document. All policies are amended in light of any new safeguarding updates.

#### 1. Introduction; what a publication scheme is and why it has been developed

One of the aims of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 is that public authorities, including schools, should be clear and proactive about the information they will make public.

To do this we must produce a publication scheme, setting out:

- The classes of information which we publish or intend to publish;
- The manner in which the information will be published; and
- Whether the information is available free of charge or on payment.

The scheme covers information already published and information which is to be published in the future. All information in our publication scheme is available in paper form.

Some information which we hold may not be made public, for example personal information.

This publication scheme conforms to the model scheme for schools approved by the Information Commissioner.

#### 2. Aims, Objectives and Vision Statement
