### Inspire Maths – Maths Mastery Curriculum

Throughout the school, teachers are currently using an innovative approach to maths teaching used by the world's leading maths countries. You may be wondering what Singapore Maths is all about. What you may not know is that Singapore has led the world in maths mastery for over a decade; its pupils become competent and proficient mathematicians at very early ages. Even better, they grow to be capable problem solvers who think mathematically with ease. The approach uses equipment and pictures to support pupil's understanding of key maths concepts and uses real life contexts when problem solving. An information letter will be going home with pupils shortly and an information coffee afternoon will be held **on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> July**. We are all very excited about developing this approach for our pupils and ensuring every child reaches their full potential in Maths.
