

Pupil Premium at Leadenham CE Primary School

The pupil premium is allocated to schools for children of statutory school age from low income families who are known to be eligible for free school meals (FSM) in both mainstream and non-mainstream settings, to children who have been looked after in the care of the Local Authority for more than six months and to children whose parents are currently serving in the armed forces.

Schools are free to spend the Pupil Premium as they see fit. However, we will be held accountable for how we have used the additional funding to support pupils from low income families. We are required to publish online information about how we have used the Premium. This will ensure that parents and others are made fully aware of the attainments of pupils covered by the Premium and the extra support that they received.

At Leadenham CE Primary School:-

- We ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all of the pupils.
- In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils, we recognise that not all pupils who received free school meals will be socially disadvantaged.
- We also recognise that not all pupils who are socially disadvantaged are registered or qualify for free school meals. We reserve the right to allocate the Pupil Premium funding to support any pupil or groups of pupils the school has legitimately identified as being socially disadvantaged.
- Pupil Premium funding will be allocated following a needs analysis which will identify priority classes, groups or individuals. Limited funding and resources means that not all children receiving free school meals will be in receipt of pupil premium interventions at one time.
