School Uniform

It is the policy of the School that all children will wear the following uniform: *M.W.*

In Winter: Grey skirt/pinafore dress/black tailored trousers (for girls)
Black/grey trousers (for boys)
Plain white polo shirt
Blue sweatshirt/jumper/cardigan with School logo

Alternatives: Blue and white striped or checked dress (for girls)

For Summer: Grey/navy blue shorts (for boys)

Practical, low-heeled shoes or sandals must be worn at all times for reasons of safety. For Infants, Velcro fasteners are recommended, so they can dress independently.

For PE: Blue T-Shirt with School logo
Blue Shorts
Socks
Infants – Plimsolls for indoors, trainers for outdoors
Juniors – Plimsolls, trainers and football boots

It is important that all children have a **separate pair of trainers/plimsolls for PE and sports.**

All clothing and equipment brought to school must be clearly marked with the child's own or family name, as items can be easily confused, when changing clothes in school.

A small supply of new uniform is available in school. Contact Miss Snook for further details.

Jewellery – Pupils with pierced ears may wear studs or small sleepers, but spiky or dangling earrings are discouraged, for safety reasons. **These must be removed for PE.** If this is not possible, then tape must be provided to cover the earrings. **At this age, other items of jewellery are not considered suitable for school.**

For outdoor activities – As we like to use the outdoor environment as part of our extended curriculum, coats and wellington boots are advised to be kept in school.

All policies are written in accordance with the Keeping Children Safe in Education Safeguarding document and the Working Together to Safeguard Children document. All policies are amended in light of any new safeguarding updates.
